The Kansas Lions Band Experience

Kansas Lions Band programs provide high school students an opportunity to rehearse, compete, and perform with their peers from across the state. Each year the Kansas Lions State Band is directed by the state's top college and high school music faculty. In past years, the band has varied from 170 – 250 participating students per year. When sufficient numbers of students apply, a smaller sub group of students will make up the Kansas Lions International Band. This group is formed to represent the Kansas Lions at the annual Lions International Convention. All Kansas Lions State Band students are eligible to participate as a member of the Kansas Lions International Band, which varies from 60-100 musicians. The Kansas Lions International Band is directed by a small cadre of instructors selected and approved by the Kansas Lions Band Committee and Kansas Lions Band Foundation.

The Kansas Lions Band Foundation, Inc. was formed to maintain support and promote annually, a band consisting of Kansas high school students. Through donations from individuals, Lions Clubs, fund raisers and the annual auction held each January at the Mid Winter Rally, the foundation has supplement the operating expenses of the State Band camps and the International Band trips to the Lions International Convention. Donations may be given as dedicated or non-dedicated. Donations given to the foundation are tax deductible under Sec. 501, c, 3 of the Internal Revenue Service Code.

The Kansas Lions Band Foundation is governed by a Board of Directors made up the Foundation President, Secretary, Treasurer, current council of governors and a group of non-governor members (one non-governor elected from each of the five sub districts).

As a service to the youth of Kansas, the Kansas Lions State Band was created in 1951. Since then over 10,000 high school musicians have participated in the Lions Band program. This had lead to the forming of lifelong friendships, opportunities to gain increased musical knowledge and skill, and a stepping stone for many to further their musical careers.

Any student who participates in the Kansas Lions State Band is eligible to be a member of the Kansas Lions International Band, which was first established in 1964.

Each band participant may seek financial sponsorship by a local Lions Club from their hometown or area. Cost of the two programs can vary from year to year, depending on location and other logistical needs.
