

“CERTIFIED LEADERSHIP CLUB AWARD”

This incentive program will consist of a reimbursement of roundtrip mileage at “Rules of Audit” (\$0.28) for one vehicle from each participating club that attends officer training. These club officers would also be eligible for “perks” at the district level, free or reduced registration fee for their club members at the district convention, free or reduced meal at the district convention or other district events and special recognition at all district events. At the conclusion of each of the training sessions there will be certificates given to the club officers that participated.

In order to retain the “Certification” there will be ongoing responsibilities for those club officers to complete throughout their year in office. There would be a requirement of the club secretary to complete the club records in a timely manner each month, (MMR each month, Activity Report as activity occurs, Club Officer Reporting Form May 15) the club must have an active membership committee in place and it would be the responsibility of the club president and board to see that the committee hold regular meetings, Induct all new members into the club in a reasonable time of joining, and orientate all new members into the club using the New Member Orientation Guide (me13a). Lastly, the club must be active in events outside the club. This would include attending all Zone Meetings in their zone and having the club represented at one or more of the following; District Convention, MWR, or State Convention. This will be monitored with a simple form that will be sent to the district GLT coordinator. This will allow us to monitor the clubs within each district and evaluate their progress.

One club from each district that completes the above listed criteria and has the most in net membership gain during the year would be recognized at State Convention with a special award including a cash award.

Each district would be given a scholarship of up to \$500.00 toward reimbursement of expenses for clubs that participate in this program. Additionally the year end cash award would be funded by the Multiple District.

The District Governor Team with the most clubs participating would also receive recognition at the State Convention with an award.
