## The Lions Band experience

The **Kansas Lions Band** gives students a place to rehearse, compete and perform with their peers from across the state. The program is directed by the state's top college music faculty and hand-picked high school directors.

Students get a well-supervised taste of college life (location rotates annually) and they leave with lifelong friends.

**State Band Camp** is a five-day concert band program. Students rehearse in sections and as a full band and perform a full-band concert. There also typically is an ensemble concert and a jazz band concert. All chairs are determined by audition.

The **International Marching Band** is a smaller, sub group of the State Band that travels to the Lions Clubs Annual International Convention when it is held in the United States. The band marches in the convention's Parade of Nations, competing against groups from around the world. The International Band trip includes a few days of sightseeing and attending special events in addition to the parade competition.

## F or Y our I nformation

### Q: How do I sign up for Lions Band?

A: Talk to your high school band director or any member of your local Lions club.

### Q: What does it cost?

A: Kansas Lions set the cost for the band programs each year. Every effort is made to keep costs as low as possible while still providing a great experience for students.

### Q: Do I have to pay my own way?

A: Money is available to help pay your band expenses either through your local Lions club or through Kansas Lions. In most cases, a student can participate at NO COST to him or her, thanks to the generosity of the Lions clubs of Kansas.

### Q: What if my high school band is very small?

A: That is OK! Students come from band programs of eight students all the way up to 200+ students.

### Q: Do I have to do State AND International Band?

A: No. But all students MUST participate in the State Band camp. The International Band is optional and open to any student that participates in State Band. Typically any student that wants to be in the International Band is welcome.
